- Does not require manager participation – managers can approve all requests from Kronos desktop
- Can be used at all accounts to automate paper processes, such as time off requests and missed punch fixes

Allows associates to get shifts covered and pick up open shifts, and provides convenient communications functionality for direct, group, and blast messaging

USE CASES

- Great for large part-time employee populations with a culture of shift swapping
- Requires management participation to approve shift changes
- Can be used at all accounts as a communications and engagement tool
